The 3 main themes that are reinforced during this 60 minute presentation are as follows:

- #1 RESPECT PEOPLE (even if you don’t agree)*
- #2 ATTACK THE PROBLEM NEVER THE PERSON!*
- #3 WORK FOR A WIN/WIN SOLUTION!*

Another great benefit to this program is the handout that can be taken home OR used in class as a discussion sheet to further reinforce this program.

Of course at the end of the program I will give out my traditional “BIG BUCKS” that teach how to do 5 magic tricks!!

Now the 3 points above are the main themes of the program but the students will also learn important concepts such as:

- TRUST is an important ingredient to Cooperation!
- Teamwork is a key factor in successful conflict resolution!!
- The importance of having a student advisory group!!
 - Why rules are so important!!
 - We all win when we learn to resolve conflict peacefully.
