



## **Helping your child reach their full potential...at home!**

1. Give your child responsibilities at a young age and continue to do so...in INSPECTOR POTENTIAL we talk a lot about responsibility and people depending on you.
2. Give your child opportunities to develop their interests. Every person has unique gifts and talents. If we fail to use and develop those talents we lose them!
3. Allow your child to take risks, make mistakes and FAIL! In INSPECTOR POTENTIAL we talk about how criticism needs to be embraced not feared. When you are critiqued you are learning how to be better at what you do and that helps you to reach your full potential.
4. Acknowledge accomplishments and make a BIG deal about it. A simple way to do this is using marbles...Each family member gets a jar to decorate as they see fit. Each time someone in the family does something that you want to appreciate you give them a marble for their jar. It's a visual technique that brings home the accomplishments of one another.
