2. What are some ways to be respectful when we are working out problems?
 - A. Never ever name call when working out a problem.
 - B. Listen to the other person. Don't think about what your going to say, listen to what they say.
 - C. Don't yell or interrupt when someone else is talking.

3. How does your school work out problems between students? Find out the process and discuss it as a class.

4. We need to work as a team to have successful conflict resolution? How do we create a strong team?
 - A. We need to have TRUST in each other.
 - B. We need to have a process/rules to follow.
 - C. By having fun together and understanding that we may not agree, but each person is entitled to their opinion.

5. Sometimes we may have a disagreement with someone we don't know very well, what can be done to build trust.
 - A. First, maintain respect as discussed above.
 - B. Second, a neutral person (mediator) can be asked to oversee the process.
 - C. Finally, remember the person you disagree with may teach you something.

Finally, remember that most conflict is the result of a lack of communication or understanding between individuals. So make sure to work on your own communication skills so that you can effectively express yourself!

Remember that if you work for a win/win solution a conflict could lead to getting to know someone better and by solving the problem you may come away with a new FRIEND!
