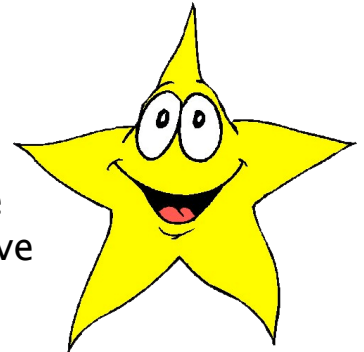
Dear Faculty Member,

Self Esteem Blog – Your students are into technology. Why not make that work for you. Start a member blog where people share something nice about classmates. This can be done so it is private to each student but you can be the administrator to make sure all comments are appropriate. By the end of the year each student will have quite a list of positive affirmations.

You're the STAR – Have students create a poster about themselves. A self portrait is a good start but then have them add pictures of family, pets and don't forget to have them do a self inventory or things like:



Favorite Songs, TV Shows, Colors, 3 Fantastic Facts about ME etc.



A Seat of Honor– This is similar to the Self Esteem blog but is less anonymous. Each day one student is selected to sit in the seat of honor as everyone gathers around and shares one special or nice thing about that person. The person in the seat of honor does not comment except to thank the person who shares the comment. At the end it is fun to have the person share how they felt during this activity.
