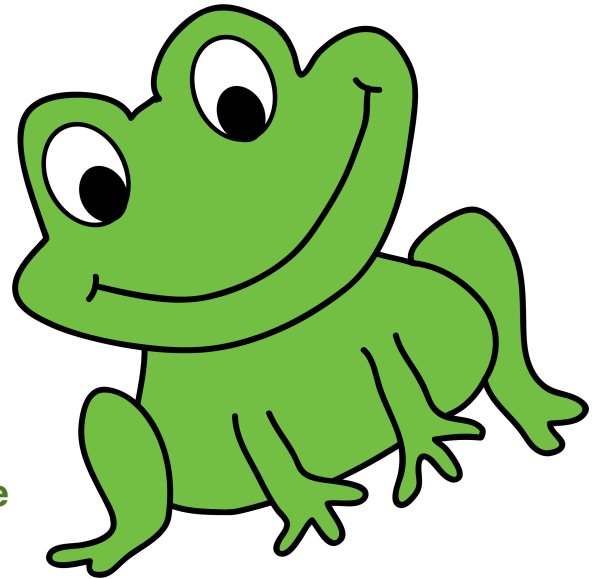


# Frog Hop Game



One factor that helps students learn is adding a physical element into the lesson. That is exactly what you do with the FROG HOP game. Create some lily pads like the one below and with a big black marker write one vocabulary word on each lily pad. Place each lily pad in a page protector.

Spread the lily pads around the floor and ask your students to hop to each lily pad saying the word when they land. Now depending on the age of your students this idea can be re-purposed with different themes than frogs and hopping!

What is popular with your students is there a way to incorporate the latest fad? How can you use their interests to get them to want to practice the skills of reading. With older kids instead of just saying the word you could ask for a definition. Also, ask what significance the word had in the story they read.
